Greetings ECRA Students and Families!

We appreciate all your patience and support as we move forward with our plan for online learning for our students! The ECRA staff are here for you and will be making sure your child's or children's needs are met to the best of our ability during this time of school closure. Online Learning

We are using Google Classroom to manage ECRA's online learning. Every student has a Gmail account that has previously been established. Your child's email will be receiving requests to them to join google classroom classes and other notifications of classwork, virtual meetings assignments, etc. as we proceed. (Please see the note below to be certain that your child is connected:

For students who have not sent up their school email, this is the procedure. Go to gmail.com, and type in firstname.lastname@ecracharter.org. If you have a hyphen or space in your name, those need to be included. The temporary password is ecra1234, at this point the student will be prompted to make a new password. Please have the student write down exactly what they type in so they can remember it for later. Once into their email, they can click on the nine dots at the top and join their classes google classroom, or use the link in the email sent from your teacher.

This week, teachers and staff are working diligently to set up the virtual classrooms, establish online procedures and fully utilize all the resources that are available to us to support your students. Teachers and staff are meeting daily in professional learning communities (PLCs) to collaborate and cooperatively plan for your child's instruction beginning next week.

Most classes will begin next week on March 23, 2020. Your child's teacher will be providing learning through a combination of methods:

- Live virtual lessons that your child can attend
- Pre-recorded lessons that your child can view
- Small groups video conferencing where your child can interact with the teacher and other students
- Individual virtual meetings or phone conference calls
- Online assignments described in detail in their Google Class
- Assignments in web-based programs such as Freckle and Edgenuity

Google Meet is a video conferencing tool that we will be using to provide learning experiences that are visual and interactive, where kids can ask questions and teachers can share information, materials and demonstrations.

LOTS of information and new tools?!! Don't Worry! The first few days next week will typically involve teachers working with students and families to understand how to use Google Classroom, the tools, the procedures and how to join virtual lessons in Google Meet. If you are struggling with the technology, let us know and we will assist you!

Internet Surveys

Last Thursday we sent home an internet use survey that had questions about your child's access to electronic devices and internet access. We have a team that has been calling the remaining families that were unable to return their surveys. Once we have all the information we are working to assist those in need with access to online learning. The schools are serving meals between 10 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. You must have your student in the car with you. Any additional children below age 18 can also receive meals.
