# **NWEA** Testing



NWEA testing will begin on Tuesday for secondary students and the following week for elementary students. You will be receiving more information from your child's teacher. This is an

important test that we administer three times a year to find out what students already know and what they are ready to

learn. Teachers are able to access detailed reports on what skills and standards are needed for your student to be successful. Students will need to test in an area free from distractions. They should get a good night's sleep the night before and have a good healthy breakfast. **Please do not** 

KEEP CALM AND DO YOUR BEST ON THE TEST

**help your student with the test**. We need to get accurate information in order to make sure your student receives the proper instruction in class. It is not a test that they pass or fail and it will not and will not affect their grade. The test adapts to your student and increases in difficulty. Students that have previously taken this test want to increase their score as part of a personal goal.
