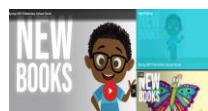

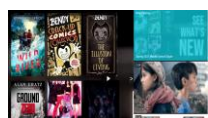

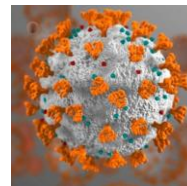
COFFEE WINNER
