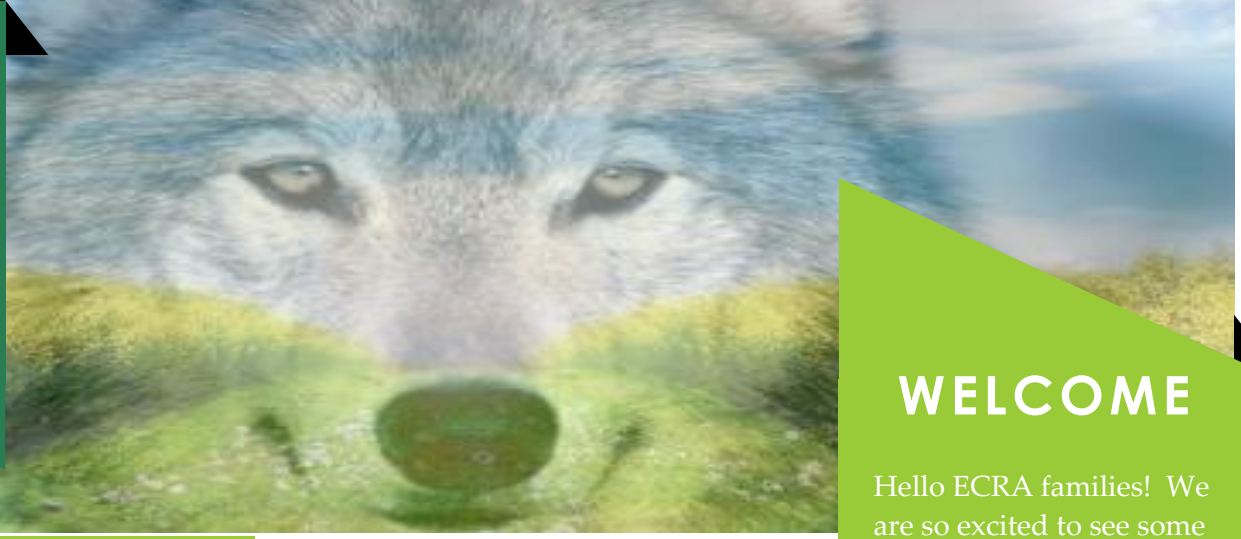

## ECRA STUDENT DAILY COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRE

(if you choose in-person learning)



Each day before sending your child to school, please review the following questions regarding your child's health.

If you answer yes to any of the questions:

**Please do not send your child to school.** Contact a medical provider or call the COVID Hotline at 855-600-3453, then call the health office at ECRA.

Questions for ECRA Students Before They Go to School

1. Does your child currently have a temperature of over 100.4 degrees?
2. In the past 24 hours, has your child experienced:
  - Sore throat, runny nose, congestion
  - New frequent, dry cough (for students with documented chronic allergies/asthma, a change in baseline cough)
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Diarrhea, vomiting
  - Loss of taste or smell
  - New onset of headache
  - Fatigue or muscle or body aches
3. Has your child recently been in close contact with anyone who has exhibited any of these symptoms?
4. Has your child recently been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?

## FRESH FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

## RENTAL/UTILITY ASSISTANCE

The state of New Mexico will distribute approximately \$170 million in federal aid for rental and utility assistance to New Mexico households experiencing financial hardship due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The Department of Finance and Administration will administer the Emergency Rental Assistance Program in partnership with the City of Albuquerque.
